

Are you getting ready for summer? Whether you're traveling far and wide or staying close to home, the library can help you have fun and save money!

Those of you with e-Readers (such as a Kindle, Nook, or i-Pad) may already know that you can download books for free from the library's website, www.ocpl.org. Items downloaded "check out" for 1, 2 or 3 weeks (your choice!), and automatically return themselves. No late fees, ever! Titles offered run the gamut from classics to popular fiction to non-fiction, for children as well as adults. As always, you need to have an OC Public Libraries card and know your PIN in order to check out books, even electronic ones! If all this is news to you, you'd like a demonstration, or even some help getting started, stop by the Service Desk at the library.

If you and your family are staying closer to home this summer, everyone can take the Summer Library Challenge. Children, teens and adults can "Read for the Win!" and go green while participating. Reading programs run the month of July. Sign up anytime at ocpl.readingbydesign.org. Log the time you spend reading, earn digital badges for participating in community events, and stop by the library weekly for small prizes and drawing tickets. Special shows are on Friday afternoons at 2:00 pm next door in the Community Center Auditorium, and include magicians, live animals and puppets.

Membership in the Friends, shopping in the bookstore and donations all help support programming at the library year-round, and especially during the summer. We'll look forward to seeing all of you soon. Thanks for all you do!

RALPHS REWARDS CARD


If you haven't already linked your Ralphs Rewards Card to San Clemente Friends of the Library, it isn't too late!


